#### Presentation

This year we are welcoming a guest speaker to give us some inspiration and historical context. Julian Richards is an archaeologist, broadcaster and self-confessed "potaholic" whom you may remember from the BBC series "Meet the Ancestors". His illustrated talk, 'A potted history of Britain' looks at the whole 6000 year history of pottery in Britain charting changes in technology, style and function over this long period. This is the subject of the new ceramics gallery that he is guest curating for Salisbury Museum. He will also be bringing a few samples from his collection for you to handle. Please feel free to bring any interesting ceramic finds you may have discovered and perhaps learn something more of their history.

## Competition

The theme for this year is "Experimentation"; Your challenge is to make a ceramic piece including some new process or material which is not part of your regular practice. This might be a different clay, glaze, decorative technique or whatever is available to you. Every attendee may submit one piece accompanied by a brief printed/written text.

All attendees may place a single vote for their favourite and there will be a small prize for the most popular.

Please feel free to bring one or two pieces of your work that you wish to share with others present. This is not a selling opportunity, simply a way of generating a conversation.
